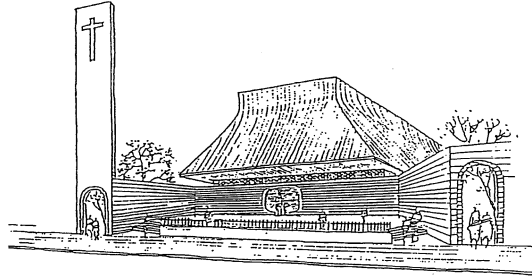

Scripture: Nehemiah 4:1-9 (NASB)

¹ Now it came about that when Sanballat heard that we were rebuilding the wall, he became furious and very angry and mocked the Jews. ² He spoke in the presence of his brothers and the wealthy men of Samaria and said, “What are these feeble Jews doing? Are they going to restore it for themselves? Can they offer sacrifices? Can they finish in a day? Can they revive the stones from the dusty rubble even the burned ones?” ³ Now Tobiah the Ammonite was near him and he said, “Even what they are building—if a fox should jump on it, he would break their stone wall down!”

⁴ Hear, O our God, how we are despised! Return their reproach on their own heads and give them up for plunder in a land of captivity. ⁵ Do not forgive their iniquity and let not their sin be blotted out before You, for they have demoralized the builders.

⁶ So we built the wall and the whole wall was joined together to half its height, for the people had a mind to work.

⁷ Now when Sanballat, Tobiah, the Arabs, the Ammonites and the Ashdodites heard that the repair of the walls of Jerusalem went on, and that the breaches began to be closed, they were very angry. ⁸ All of them conspired together to come and fight against Jerusalem and to cause a disturbance in it.

⁹ But we prayed to our God, and because of them we set up a guard against them day and night.

Introduction to Pastor Chow Lien-Hua:

Pastor Chow Lien Hua served in GBC for 46 years. He also was a recognized Christian leader in Taiwan serving as chaplain to Taiwan's former presidents Chiang Kai-shek, Chiang Ching-kuo, and Lee Teng-hui. He passed away in 2016 at the age of 96.

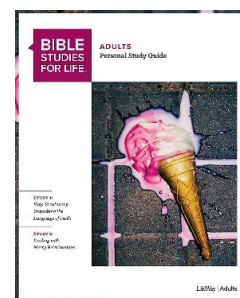
Born in Shanghai, Chow graduated from the University of Shanghai in business management. He later went to the United States in 1949 to study theology. He completed his BDiv (1951) and PhD (1954) at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. Later he did post-doctoral research at Princeton Theological Seminary and was a visiting scholar at Oxford University. He later became chairman of the Taiwan Baptist Christian Seminary, president of Asia Baptist Graduate Theological Seminary, and later became GBC’s Senior Pastor.

Application for Yearly Parking Permit

GBC members can apply for a yearly parking permit between now and mid-February. Application forms are available at the front desk and must be signed by a GBC minister or pastor before submission. When picking up your new parking permit, you will need to return your old parking permit and pay a NT\$ 200 fee at the front desk. (See details at the front desk.)

Note: GBC parking spaces are available on a first-come-first-park basis. When all spaces are filled, no more cars may enter the garage. Parking alternatives near GBC are: parking basement of Taiwan University; below the overpass on Hsin-Hai Road sec. 1; or Hsin-Hai Road sec. 1 roadsides.
